ways.



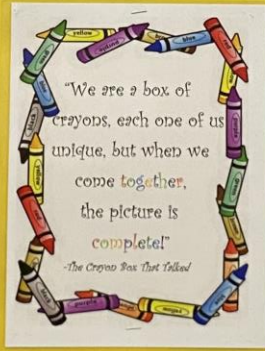

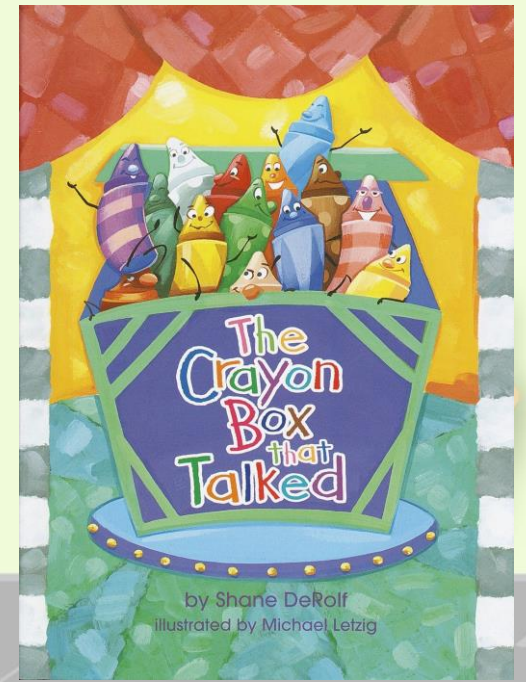
