- Grade 5 Farewell Assembly
  - Monday June 24<sup>th</sup> after recess
    - Kids and parents invited
    - Kids get certificates and awards
    - Pizza and ice cream in multipurpose room
      - Pizza donated by Panago
    - Last year PAC purchased juice, chips and sundae ingredients as well as balloons (ones with numbers)
      - Hoping PAC can pay for that again this year
    - They leave the gym wearing sunglasses
      - \$200 to get them on Amazon
      - Parent could make them for cheaper
      - This is a surprise for the grade 5s
- 2024 2025 Preliminary Budget
  - o Aligns with Strategic Plan
    - Student success is most important
  - Shared breakdown of Provincial Operating Grant
    - Basic allocation is \$8915 / student
  - Most of the money goes to staffing

- Shared some of the assumptions
  - Teacher raise will be funded by government
  - Will align with new strategic plan
- Budget Pressures
  - Inflation (3-6%)
  - Recruitment challenges
  - Demand for spaces
  - Student transportation
- Preliminary Estimates
  - Most is on salary and benefits
- Allocating the Budget to Schools
  - Part 1 ... follow collective agreement
  - Part 2 .... Allocations based on the size and level of the school
- Operation of Schools
  - Learning Support Services
  - Indigenous Education Department
  - Facilities Department
  - Information Technology Department
- Budget Allocations
  - 68% goes to schools
  - 17% Centralized Education Services
  - 12% Operations and Transportation
  - 3% District Business Administration
- School Budget
  - \$146,000 for McMillan
    - About \$93,000 goes to clerical and noon hour services
    - Rest is given to classes and grades (about \$30 per student)
  - We try to keep \$40,000 in the school bank account (separate from district allocation)
