 - Next Tuesday is Tacky Tourist Day
- Photos
 - Suzi has been in contact with Darby Photos
 - o They are willing to do the individual and class photos at the same time
 - Darby doesn't typically do the paper frame like back in the old days
 - We will ask them to do it inside
 - We are going to go with someone new and admin will decide
- School Plan for 2024-2025
 - o For 3 years we've had a SEL goal
 - Still have lots of work to do here so we're not losing sight of this
 - Data (MDI) showed 2-6% of students experienced bullying
 - Last year it was in the 30s
 - Also seeing a significant increase in students feeling they have a trusted adult
 - Still low in "student well-being"
 - We have also picked a literacy goal
 - Anecdotally teachers are concerned about students ability to write
 - We are going to focus on reading and see if it will trickle down to writing
 - We will collect writing data in June as baseline data
 - School plan will be posted on the school website by the end of June
 - It is a fluid document so input from parents is welcome
- Last Day of School
 - First day of school we had balloons and photo stations set up
 - This was a huge success and really built community
 - Want to have a place set up for parents to take photos, etc on the last day
 - The same signs will be up for the last day of school

Financial Report - Caitlyn

- Gaming Account: \$11,050.89
 - We still need to pay \$1500 for waterslides
- General Account: 38, 215.40
 - Wall people from Fun Fair have not cashed their cheque
 - Will be about \$37,000 after they do
- Petty Cash is at \$441
 - o We'd like to clear it out before the end of the school year
 - Will put it in the bank account
- Fun Fair Revenue was \$18,898.59
 - o Costs were \$6295.00
 - Fun Fair Profit was \$12, 603.59
 - o This is the highest profit ever!
