Gaming Account: \$9550.89

- Spirit Wear have sold roughly 1,268 so far ... running until October 30th
- Treasure Chest -
 - Last year we donated money to the McMillan Food Pantry (as gift cards)
 - We will do the same thing this year
 - We are going to up the price from \$1.00 to \$2.00
